# Getting the Wireless Hotspot Password



*Printing from a “hotspot” means that you can print from a wireless device without connecting to your school network.*




# Connecting your iPhone to the printer's hotspot using the password




Choose the Device Name and enter the password





Send and image to print by selecting the bottom left arrow
