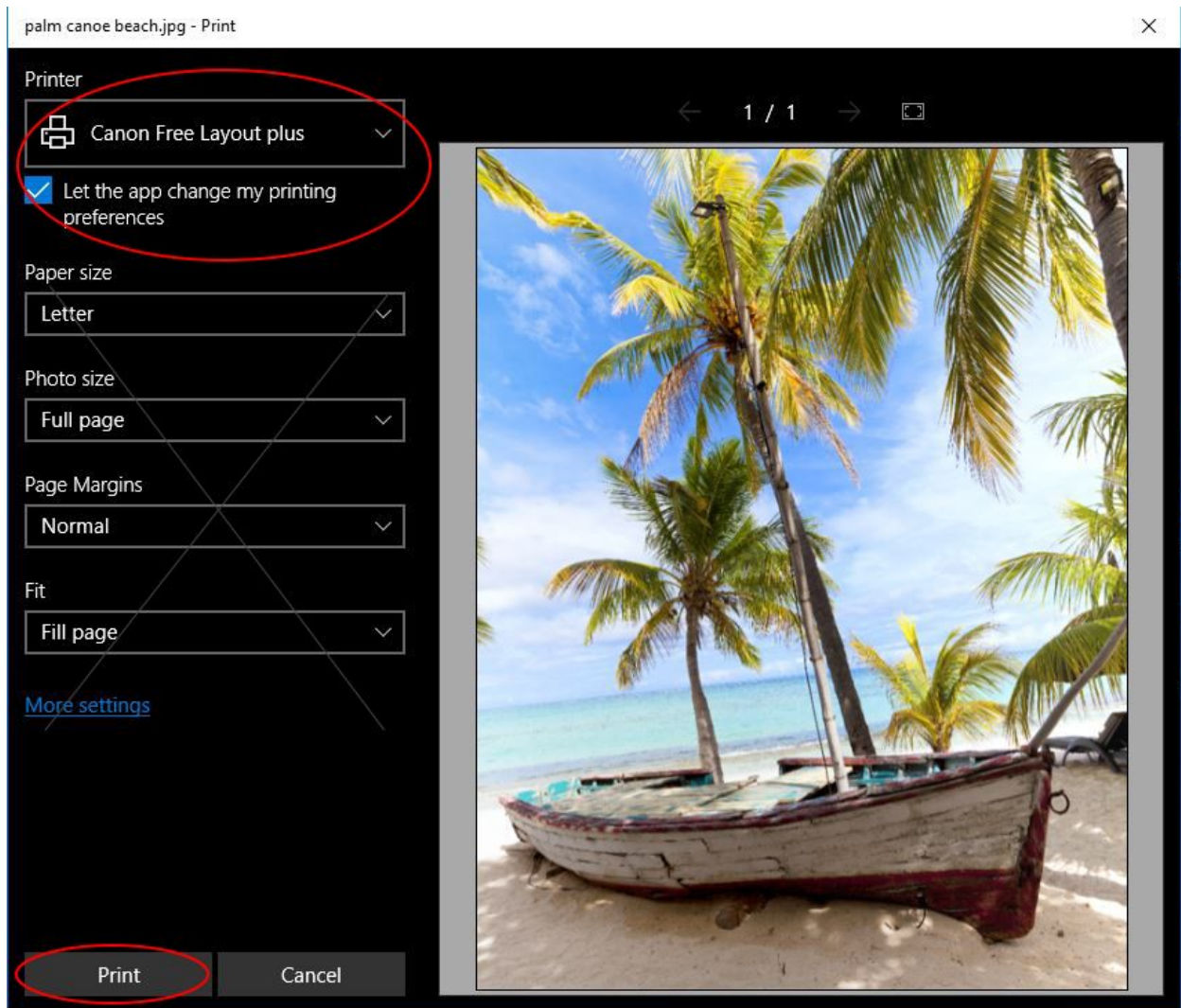


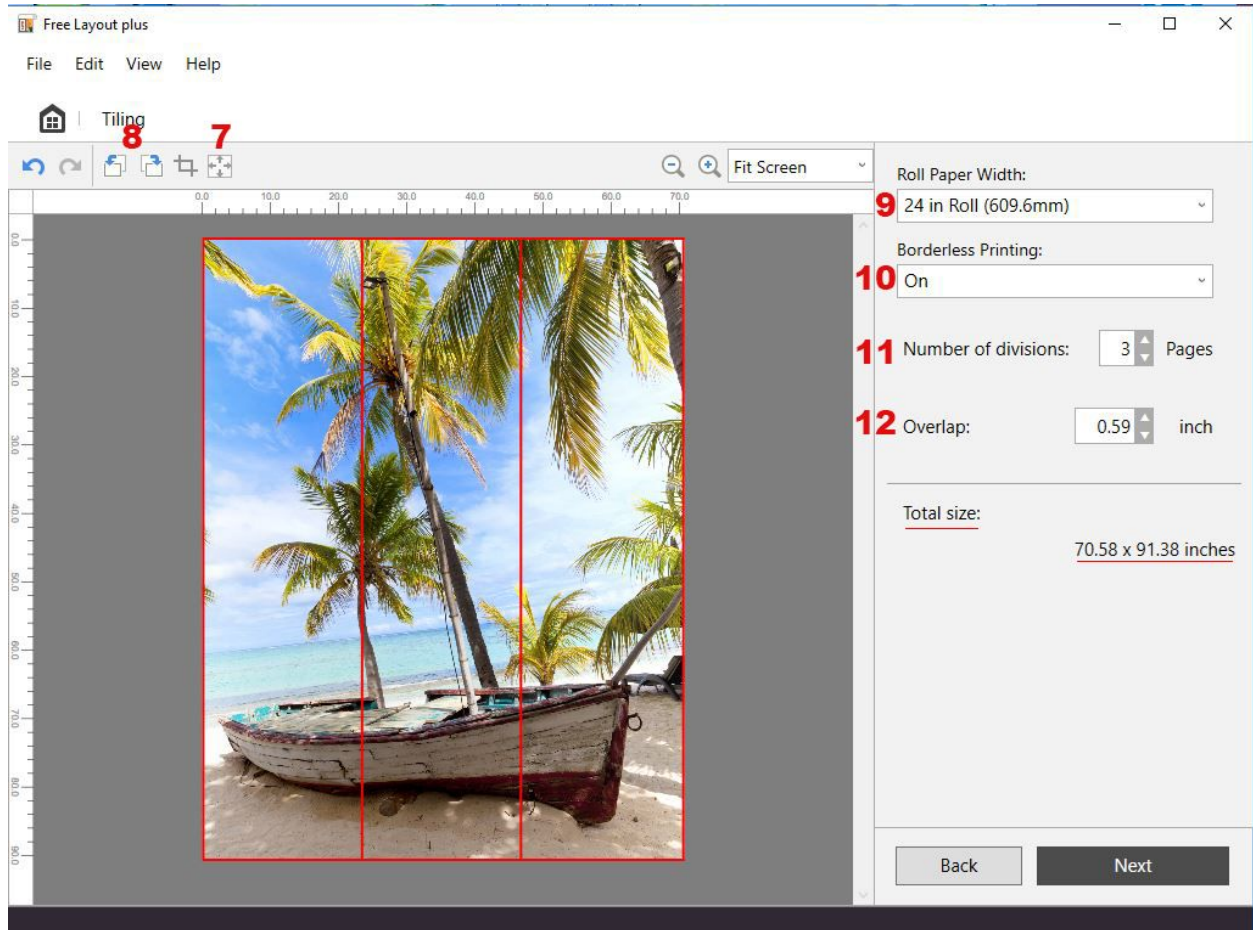
## Free Layout Plus

*\*Make sure you are using a clear image so it will look great when you print at large scale!\**

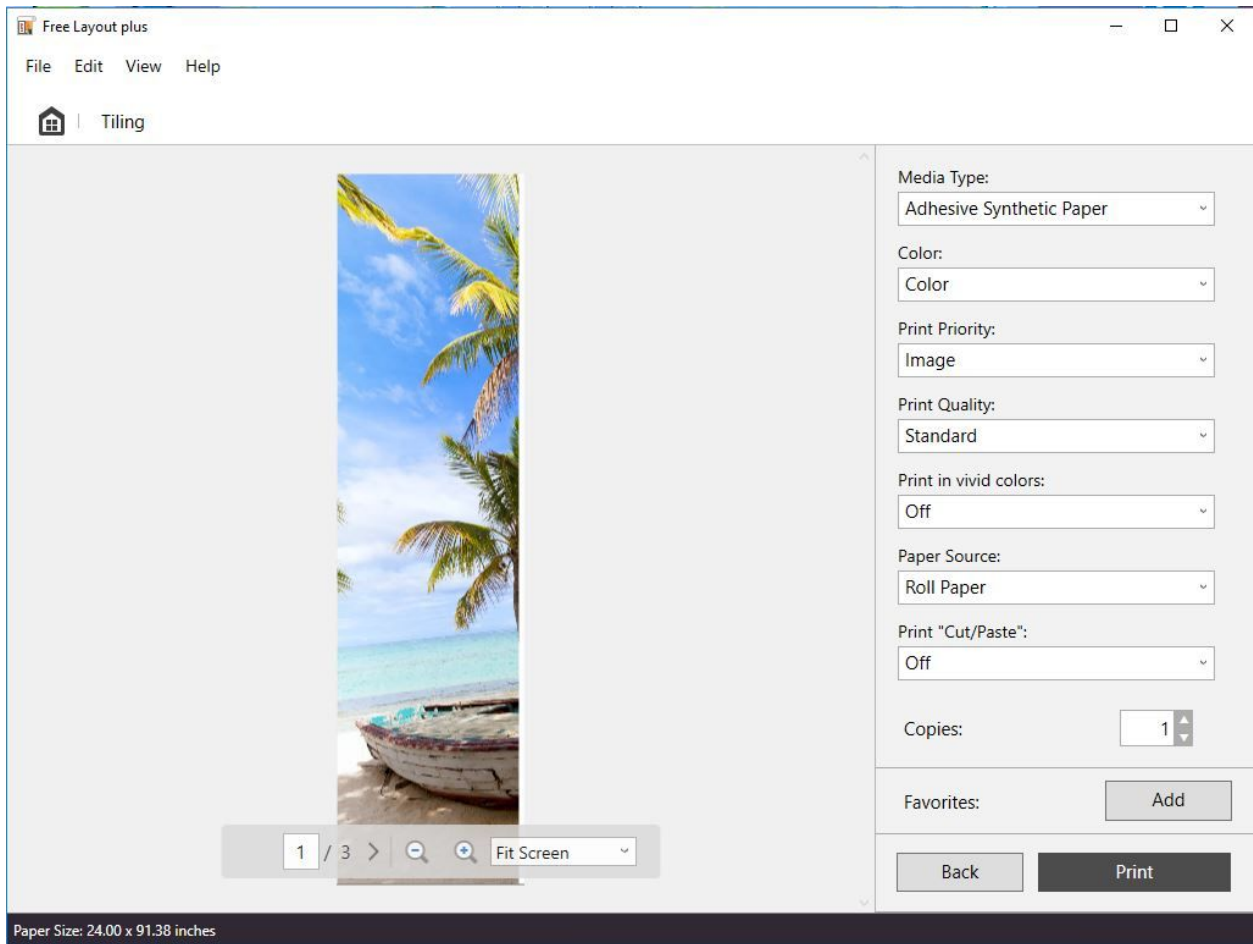
1. Double click your image on the desktop so that it opens up in a preview window.
2. Select Print.



3. In the Printer drop down menu, Switch it from the printer to Free Layout Plus.
4. (Don't worry about any other settings) Just click the print button.
5. From here the Free Layout Plus window will open.
6. Choose Tiling.



7. Click the Erase Margin Button.
8. Click the Rotate Right or Left 90 degrees buttons if you would like to change the orientation of your image.
9. Make sure the roll width is the correct size (24 in or 36 in).
10. Turn Borderless On if you would like your image to print edge to edge.
11. Number of divisions allows you to choose the amount of panels that you would like. ( The total size will differ depending on how many panels you have)
12. Choose how big you would like the overlap to be between panels.
13. Click next.



14. For best print results, change Media Type from Auto to the type of paper that you're using.

15. You can change the Print Quality if you would like but Standard prints a clear image.

16. Paper Source should **ALWAYS** be Roll Paper.

17. Print.
